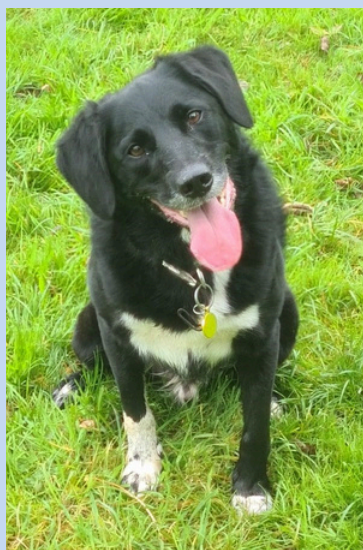


Exciting Pet Health Plan (PHP) update
